## Get your Taxes Together: Bringing Key Records to your Certified General Accountant

Filing your income tax return often seems a daunting task, even with the help of a certified general accountant. Consider the following checklist to help make the tax season a smooth one.

Note: You should have received all your applicable tax documentation by the end of March.
